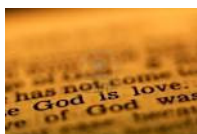

## Zebras Mission: Valentine Grams

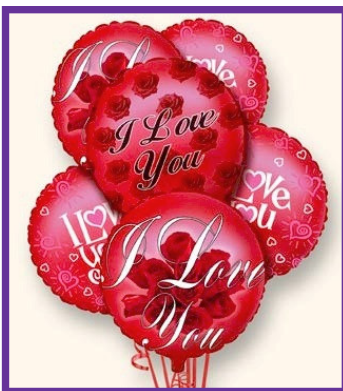
It’s that time of year to show some love! Starting February 7th, the Zebras will be selling Valentine Grams. Valentine Grams are

would see them through the darkest of times. He said, "Be sure you put your feet in the right place, then stand firm."

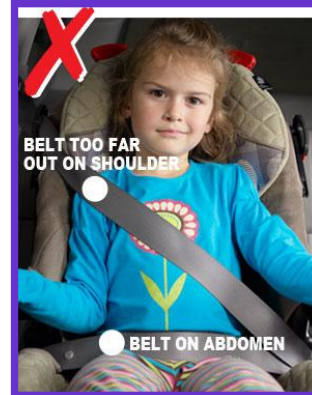
These two men deserve to be honored and remembered for their actions and their refusal to give up or be moved and their reliance on the sovereign Lord above. Happy President's Day!

# Buckle Up!

Published on ca.gov is the new law for child booster seats and safety seats which

states: "Children \*MUST\* be secured in an appropriate child passenger restraint (safety seat or booster seat) **IN THE BACK SEAT OF A VEHICLE** until they are at least **8 YEARS OLD** or **4'9" IN HEIGHT.**"

This law went into effect 01/01/2012. Make sure to buckle up!
